Graduation Requirements and Credits

A reminder that all Grade 12 students are required to complete **three Provincial Graduation Assessments** in order to graduate with a Dogwood. The Literacy 12 Assessment is scheduled for November. Please ensure your student plans accordingly, as this is a necessary step toward graduation. Mr. Ruben will share more information as we get closer to the date, including opportunities for students to complete missed Literacy 10 or Numeracy 10 assessments.

CLC 12 is a required Grade 12 course and must be successfully completed in order to graduate. Please pay close attention to the specific schedules for Ms. Yeo's and Ms. Derkson's CLC 12 classes. CLC 12 includes a combination of scheduled in-person classes and independent learning time throughout the year, so students are responsible for knowing when they are expected to attend and for keeping up with their work between scheduled classes.

CLC 12 culminates in the **Grade 12 Capstone Project**, anticipated to take place in May 2027. Completion of the Capstone is a required component of CLC 12 and an important part of each student's graduation pathway.

Planning for the Costs of Grade 12

As families look ahead, we also want to acknowledge that Grade 12 comes with a number of optional events, celebrations, and experiences that can involve additional costs and become the financial realities of Grade 12. We encourage families to plan ahead where possible.

Some anticipated expenses may include:

- Grad Cruise: approximately \$150
- Grad Banquet: approximately \$160
- Grad Photos
- Grad clothing and attire: grad clothing, dress/suit, shoes, hair/makeup, nails, etc.
- Additional student-led activities and celebrations
- Grad school fee

Not every student will choose to participate in every opportunity, and costs will vary depending on individual choices. Our goal is always to balance tradition and celebration with accessibility, and we will communicate costs and deadlines as early and clearly as possible throughout the year.
